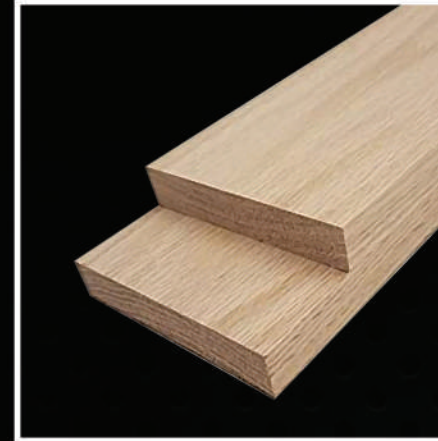

It is also used to make quality boxes or crates. It can hold heavy-weight goods, due to their light-weight, they are easy to transport and easy to handle. Wood finishes well and has medium resistance to decay. Thickness : 1",2",3" & 4", Width 1",2",3",4",6",8",10",12" and length 13'.
